WHEREAS, the Chief Judge is charged by Rule 2.215(b)(4), Florida Rules of Judicial Administration, with the responsibility of assigning judges to the courts and divisions in the Circuit; and


WHEREAS, there is a desire to distribute the workload of the County Court on an equitable and geographical basis; and

WHEREAS, due to the elevation of Judge James Morgan to the circuit bench on February 14, 2025, cases in the Middle Keys Division must be temporarily reassigned;

It is therefore, ORDERED that:

1. The County Court caseload in the Middle Keys Division shall be assigned as follows:
  - a. All new county criminal cases filed in the Middle Keys Division shall be assigned to Judge Mark Wilson. All pending cases currently assigned to Judge James Morgan shall be reassigned to Judge Mark Wilson.
  - b. All new and pending county civil, small claims, municipal and county ordinance violations and civil traffic infractions requiring a hearing in front of a judge shall be temporarily assigned to Judge Albert Kelley.
2. This Order is effective March 20, 2025. With the exception of the Middle Keys Division assignments outlined above, all assignments and provisions in Administrative Order 2.005/23-1, *County Court Division Assignments/Official Headquarters* entered on August 30, 2023, remain in full force and effect.
3. Administrative Order 2.005/24-1, *County Court Division Assignments/Official Headquarters* entered on November 15, 2024, is rescinded upon the effective date of this order.
