ORDER SUSPENDING COURT
OPERATIONS DUE TO THREAT
OF TROPICAL STORM CONDITIONS

WHEREAS, Monroe County Mayor Holly Merrill Raschein declared a State of Local Emergency for Monroe County on Tuesday, November 5, 2024, due to the approach of Tropical Storm Rafael; and

WHEREAS, a Tropical Storm warning exists for all of Monroe County and the Florida Keys and conditions along the Overseas Highway will deteriorate rapidly, not allowing for safe travel for judges, staff and litigants to and from the three Monroe County Courthouses; it is

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the operations of the courts of Monroe County and the Sixteenth Judicial Circuit shall be suspended beginning Tuesday, November 5, 2024, at 5 p.m. Court operations will resume Thursday, November 7, 2024, at 8:30 a.m., if weather conditions permit.


HOWEVER, the following court related functions **will** continue:

1. Juvenile detention hearings;
2. Dependency shelter hearings;
3. Issuance of domestic violence restraining orders;
4. Marchman Act involuntary commitments;
5. First Appearance hearings will be held Wednesday, November 6, 2024, from the Monroe County Detention Center on Stock Island at 9:00 am for all three court locations, if conditions permit.
6. Law enforcement officers seeking search warrant and arrest warrant review by the duty judge shall follow night and weekend procedures by contacting Monroe County Sheriff's Office dispatch.
7. Law Enforcement shall continue Baker Act involuntary detoxification procedures.
