WHEREAS, A5S7, Fla. Const., provides that a circuit or county court may hold civil and criminal trials and hearings in any place within the territorial jurisdiction of the court as designated by the chief judge of the circuit; and

WHEREAS, the prompt disposition of cases in the circuit and county court would best be achieved by bringing the courts closer to its officers and residents of the county; it is therefore

ORDERED that:

A. The following facilities shall be designated as branch courthouses in and for the Sixteenth Judicial Circuit (Monroe County), Florida;

1. Monroe County Branch Courthouse at Marathon;
2. Monroe County Branch Courthouse at Plantation Key;
3. Federal Court Facility at Key West;
4. Any other facility which the Board of County Commissioners, upon approval of the Chief Judge, may hereafter secure for purposes of conducting court business.
