WHEREAS, the judiciary of the Sixteenth Judicial Circuit desires to express to jurors their importance to the overall justice system, and

WHEREAS, the judiciary of the Sixteenth Judicial Circuit acknowledges the court's inability to function without jurors as a working partner within that system, and

WHEREAS, the judiciary of the Sixteenth Judicial Circuit intends to make a concerted effort to eliminate as many inconveniences to jurors as possible, it is hereby,

ORDERED that jury selection shall be limited to the hours prior to 6:00 P.M. on the date of jury reporting. When any additional juries are needed which were unable to be selected prior to 6:00 P.M. on the date of jury reporting, a selected venire may be asked to report on the following or a subsequent day for possible selection on a petit jury.
